The company started out as a very labor intensive plant and produced slightly over 25 million bricks per year. In 1972, the original plant was torn down and plant #1 was built with automation in every department, producing 35 million bricks annually with 35 employees. In 1986, plant #2 was built, increasing capacity to 70 million bricks per year, with 65 employees. Plant #3 was added in 1998, bringing total capacity to 115 million bricks per year. Plant #4 was added in Fall 2006, increasing the overall capacity to 165
